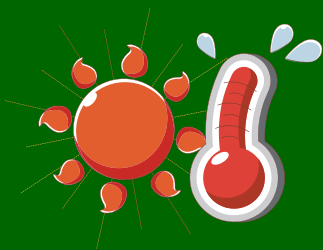

This is yes, yes, yes (*nod head*)

This is no, no, no (*shake head*)

Early Literacy Tip:

Singing with your child is a wonderful early literacy activity because songs easily and simply break down words into smaller sounds through tones. Songs and rhymes help your child identify patterns, like rhyming words, that will help them to start reading.
